Pizzachini Fry

This recipe is very flexible; season it as you like, and use whatever you have from the garden or leftover sauce within reason.

Non-GMO Zucchini chunks to fill a 13" skillet (it will cook down)

1 onion, chopped

1 cup of breading mix (below)

1 -1/2 cups of pizza or spaghetti sauce



Steam or saute zucchini and onion with water or olive oil until tender. When tender, add breading mix and pizza sauce, and continue cooking until it forms almost a cheese-like

consistency. Breading Mix - 1/2 cup crushed NON-GMO cornflakes or other bread crumbs, 1/2 cup flour, seasoned to taste with garlic powder, onion powder, salt and vegan beef-style seasoning. (This mixture should be flavorful even before cooking.)

A GARDEN OF TRUTH

the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it." Gen 2:15 As I have spent time in my garden and orchard this year, I have come to realize some important lessons in character formation. Just as plants have to be cultivated, we have to strive to cultivate the fruits of the Spirit.

Our raspberry patch is the most vigorous of all our orchard and garden with some of the stalks towering 7 or 8 feet into the air. Each year we cut off all the old "canes" that have produced berries and trim back the new ones to keep them to a "pickable"



height. The first time I thinned them out, it almost hurt to cut all these things out, at least until the next year, when I saw what a positive difference it made in the health and productivity of the raspberries. John

the Baptist told the Pharisees and Sadducees to *"Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:"* Matt. 3:8 A mere form of Christianity (a dead stalk) is not of the least value. It is destitute of saving power, having in it no reformative energy. In the same way that I have to prune back the raspberries, cutting off the dead stalks, we must cut off the things in our life that are dead in sin. When this is actually carried out in our life, others will

see the "fruit meet for repentance." Just as Zacchaeus not only stopped stealing, but restored what he had taken fourfold, **(Luke19:8)** we must not only turn away from our sin, but must make restitution for past sins.

Unfortunately, raspberries aren't the only vigorous growing plants in our garden. This year weeds overtook the garden. It is amazing to me how carefully the fruiting plants must be cultivated and nurtured, yet weeds grow rampant without any tender loving care. A good gardener knows weeds must be pulled up by the roots. John said, *"And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire."* Matt. 3:10 In the same way, we must get to the root of the sin problem to be rid of the problem. Pride, selfishness, the love of money, and ultimately, separation from God is at the root of many sins.

By contrast, to avert sin, we must abide in Christ. Jesus said, "I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing." John 15:5

This reminds me of my vigorously growing grape. After I first bought it, it didn't produce grapes for years. So one day I decided to make stuffed grape leaves from it since it wasn't good for much else. Again I "painfully" cut off leaves-- live ones, this time. Amazingly, the next year it produced grapes. Upon obtaining another grape vine, I pruned it the first year, and sure enough it is already producing grapes. I didn't realize at the time that this is how God cleanses his people. Jesus said, "I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit." John 15:1,2 In the Greek, the word for purging or pruning is actually "to cleanse". Our tribulations in this world are to cleanse and help us to manifest the fruit of the Spirit. "...My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him: For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth... but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness. Now, no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby." Heb. 12:5,6,10b,11

Another writer explained it this way, "There is a constant tendency to be more profuse in foliage than in fruit. The strength and nourishment which goes to support the excessive foliage, is taken from the grapes. Therefore the husbandman prunes away the useless growth, that the fruit may be richer and more abundant. Thus it is that the Heavenly Husbandman deals with his vineyard. In prosperity the followers of Jesus often turn their thoughts and energies to gratifying themselves, to securing earthly treasure, to enjoying the ease and pleasure and luxury of the world, while they bring forth little fruit to the glory of God. Then the Husbandman, to



promote the fruitfulness of the branches, comes with the pruning-knife of disappointment, loss, or bereavement, and cuts away the hindering growth". **{RH, September 11, 1883}**

Paul wrote, "... but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; and patience, experience; and experience, hope:" Romans 5:3,4 Just as Jesus' death on the cross brought hope for repentant sinners, "we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28

REAPING A BITTER HARVEST

Lately, we have been seeing some scary headlines like **DECLINE IN BIRDS**, **NOT JUST BEES**, **LINKED TO NEONICOTINOID PESTICIDES**. Hans de Kroon of Radboud University stated, *"Neonicotinoids were always regarded as selective toxins. But our results suggest that they may affect the entire ecosystem."* www.cbc.ca/news/technology/decline-in-birds-not-just-bees-linked-to-neonicotinoid-pesticides-1.2706542

An article from PAN - Pesticide Action Network states, "*GE {genetically engineered} corn & neonicotinoid seed treatments go hand-in-hand.*" <u>http://www.panna.org/blog/ge-com-sick-honey-bees-whats-link</u> Neonicotinoids are also often linked to **GMO (genetically modified organism)** soy and other Roundup ready crops. Also, many GMO crops, like Bt corn (corn with insecticide engineered into it), have the pesticides actually included in the plants just like neonicotinoids.

"In the past 20 years, neonicotinoids have become one of the fastest-growing pesticide classes. In contrast to most other pesticides, which must be sprayed directly onto plants close to the time that insect extermination is desired, neonicotinoids are simply used to treat seeds before planting. As a treated plant grows, it absorbs the poison into every single one of its tissues, making the entire plant toxic. That means that even the plant's flowers, nectar and pollen become deadly, killing pollinators that visit the crop". www.naturalnews.com/046095_neonicotinoids_silent_spring_bees.html##ixz238KkwR44S

This problem again demonstrates the fact, that changing the seed affects the whole plant, which in turn affects animal life, and ultimately humans. The Bible states, "*Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.*" Galatians 6:7 When we plant the seeds of death in our world or in our bodies, their natural result will be death. However, just like a physical seed may take a while to sprout, the results of the seeds of death are not always seen immediately, for a while we may think they are "selective toxins". I BELIEVE NATURE IS GIVING US A WARNING OF WHAT WE WILL REAP IF WE CONTINUE BREAKING GOD'S LAWS. Ultimate health and happiness is dependent not only upon keeping God's moral law—the Ten Commandments, but also his physical laws.

"GMOs, or "genetically modified organisms," are plants or animals created through the gene splicing techniques of biotechnology (also called genetic engineering, or GE). This experimental technology merges DNA from different species, creating unstable combinations of plant, animal, bacterial and viral genes that cannot occur in nature or in traditional crossbreeding. Virtually all commercial GMOs are engineered to withstand direct application of herbicide and/or to produce an insecticide." Nongmoproject.org This is changing the "law", the DNA that God placed in the plant. Jesus said, "What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder [separate]." Mark 10:9 Man is still a long way from understanding DNA as God does. Man experimenting with DNA and genetic modification might be compared to a small child playing with his daddy's power tools. It spells DISASTER. Some examples of test GMO's include tomatoes mixed with fish, or rice with human genes.

One of God's statutes^{**} or health laws found in **Deut. 22:9** says, "Thou shalt not sow thy vineyard with divers seeds: lest the fruit of thy seed which thou hast sown, and the fruit of thy vineyard, be defiled." Strong's Concordance defines the word divers as the "Dual of [the word for prison] in the original sense of separation; two heterogeneities..." According

to Webster's Dictionary –Heterogeneous describes substances "*Of a different kind or nature; unlike or dissimilar in kind...*"In other words, this refers to mixing two substances that would not naturally mix. It is going against nature or "leaving the natural use". **Romans 1:27**

The same word for divers is used in Lev 19:19 "Ye shall keep my statutes... Thou shalt not let thy cattle [animal or dumb beast] gender with a **diverse kind**: thou shalt not sow thy field with **mingled seed**: neither shall a garment **mingled** of linen and woollen come upon thee." This reiterates, don't mix up what God has separated. Don't mix your horse with your cow, and don't mix

plants (linen) with animals (woolen) trying to create and interweave your own mixed up fabric/material, or concoction. Don't think you can improve on God. Notice that God said the **fruit** of the vineyard would be defiled, this may imply that the **vineyard** itself is also defiled." This accurately describes the 2 main problems with GMOs.

1. The defiled fruit has Health Hazards. Studies have found that Genetically Engineered Foods trigger adverse immune system responses and the Bt Toxin has even been found in blood of women and fetuses who were tested. Dr. Mercola's footnoted article quotes, "Researchers found distinct changes to the intestines of animals fed GMOs compared to those fed non-GMOs. This confirms other studies done by US researchers. Significant changes occurred in the digestive systems of the test animals' major




organs including the liver, kidneys, pancreas, genitals and more." Another study found, "This not only may relate to a rise in obesity, but to increases in many modern diseases. These diseases include diabetes, digestive disorders, inflammatory bowel disease, colitis, autism spectrum disorders (ASD) (ADD), autoimmune diseases, sexual dysfunction, sterility, asthma, COPD and many more." http://articles.mercola.com/sites/articles/archive/2012/08/07/genetically-engineered-foods-hazards.aspx

2. Super weeds are created. God's Word implies that the vineyard also would be defiled. Although the intent was the opposite, GMO Roundup ready crops have actually created resistant weeds requiring MORE PESTICIDES.

The <u>New York Times</u> published an article stating, "Just as the heavy use of antibiotics contributed to the rise of drug-resistant supergerms, American farmers' near-ubiquitous use of the weedkiller Roundup has led to the rapid growth of tenacious new superweeds." <u>www.nytimes.com/2010/05/04/business/energy-environment/04weed.html?pagewanted=all</u>

It really all boils down to, "Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse; A blessing, if ye obey the commandments of the LORD your God... And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way... "Deut. 11:26-28 Before you decide what to put on your plate next time, think with the reasoning of Paul, What doth nature itself teach? (1 Cor.11:14)
