Cultivate a Missionary Spirit—Many people like theme parties – work for God by making these occasions a witnessing/educational opportunity for others. Have a mission awareness "party". Different people can tell about the country they represent, sharing the main religion and whether it is "reached" or "unreached" by Christian missionaries. You may choose to collect donations for a mission project. Other profitable themes might include a parenting "party" focusing on Biblical parenting skills, marriage/couples "party" teaching Biblical perspectives on the roles of husbands and wives. It will take some creativity to make these both enjoyable and useful. There are also an unlimited number of health themes that could be used, simple (and appropriate) anatomy and physiology games for little people, cooking demonstrations, hydrotherapy classes, natural remedies/herbal "tea parties", or mix and match. This is simply a new twist, using what people enjoy to teach them God's way. Standing but a step from His heavenly throne, Christ gave the commission to His disciples; "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:"

"Go ye" is the language of a command not a suggestion. As Hudson Taylor put it: "The Great Commission is not an option to be considered; it is a command to be obeyed."

OVER 2 BILLION PEOPLE IN THE VORLD ARE CONSIDERED UNREACHED BY THE GOSPEL.

But despite this, few engage in spreading the truth to those who do not have it. Over 2 billion people in the world are considered unreached by the gospel. This number only includes those who are part of ethnic groups in which the entire group is considered unreached.

When Christ gave the command to teach all "nations", the word used was "*ethnos*" meaning "*a race (as of the same habit), that is, a tribe.*" This means the fulfillment of the Great Commission is not just to plant a church in every country, such as India or the USA, but to insure that everyone in every "people group" or "ethnic group" has had the opportunity to hear the gospel. At the present according to some sources, 6, 898 "people groups" are considered unreached.

Many sit back and wait for others to spread the gospel, while they hoard their money, time, and energy for selfish

interests. But if we look at reality, can we really call ourselves Christian while doing this? Think about it this way. If the average person sleeps 8 hours each night, during this time more than 10,000 people die without hearing the gospel. In fact, every minute, more people die without hearing the gospel, than the average person meets in a day. If you have ever met someone who has had a child die, you can imagine some of pain they feel, but every day thousands upon thousands of God's children die, never having heard, nor having had the



opportunity to hear about his love. Imagine the pain God feels. Consider this story...

An evangelist was ill and in bed when he received a telephone call requesting either a visit from a minister or Bible Correspondence lessons. The evangelist explained that he was in bed ill, and his fellow-workers were out of town, but the lessons would be sent immediately. He took the name and address, but forgot to send the lessons.

Two weeks later his wife saw the name and address and asked about them. Remembering his promise the evangelist iumped into his car and drove to the address. A lady answered the bell. When the



jumped into his car and drove to the address. A lady answered the bell. When the evangelist introduced himself and explained his mission, her eyes welled with tears. "It was my brother," she sobbed. "He was the pastor of a church, but recently he'd had doctrinal differences with his people, and had become discouraged and despondent. We buried him two days ago." She paused, then added, "He took his own life."

Think back on what you did today. How much have you done for the furthering of the truth? If we truly want our Saviour to come again and put an end to the suffering in this world, shouldn't we be trying to hasten His return by spreading the gospel to the entire planet? Jesus Christ does not want anyone to die eternally lost. His death on the cross forever established the fact that He wants everyone to be saved. Multitudes are starving for the Bread of Life. They need to be told about salvation. They cannot make their decision for or against Someone of whom they have never heard. Will you tell them?





Job asked, "*Can that which is unsavoury be eaten without salt?*" (Job 6:6) I use some salt, and always have, because salt, instead of being deleterious, is actually essential for the blood. It is a myth that all salt is bad. You do not have to eliminate sodium completely for good health. Sodium is an essential nutrient needed to make nerves and muscles work properly and also to maintain electrolyte balance, however, you do need the right amount. In **Mark 9:50** Jesus states that "*Salt is good: but if the salt have lost his saltness, wherewith will ye season it?.."* Thus, the words of Christ support the use of some salt. However, the Word of God also speaks of uninhabited salt lands comparing them to the curse for trusting in man. (Jer. 17:5, 6) The Bible and history also record stories of conquerors who sowed lands with salt to keep anything from growing. (Judges 9:45)

It is true, however, that too much salt is not good for our bodies. Evidence shows a relationship between higher levels of sodium intake and risk of high blood pressure, heart disease and strokes. But recently, Brian Strom, Professor of Public Health and Preventive Medicine from the University of Pennsylvania stated, *"New studies support previous findings that reducing sodium from very high intake levels to moderate levels improves health, but they also suggest that lowering sodium intake too much may actually increase a person's risk of some health problems."* http://www8.nationalacademies.org/onpinews/newsitem.aspx?RecordID=18311



The key is balance. Balance of water and salt, balance of sodium, potassium and magnesium. Of course, choosing a natural salt, free from harmful additives is important too. Studies show "A typical American consumes an average of almost two teaspoons a day of salt. About 80 percent of our daily sodium consumption comes from eating processed or restaurant foods." www.news-medical.net/news/20130514/Processed-and-fast-food-salt-levels-remain-high-as-ever-new-study-reports.aspx

Here are three easy ways to keep your sodium levels in balance:

- 1. Eat more fresh food, and limit canned and processed food
- 2. Learn to season with herbs, garlic, onions and vegetables
- 3. Eat foods high in potassium and other minerals like leafy greens, orange vegetables, bananas, oranges, potatoes (with the skin), beans and avocado.

In Matthew 5:13 Jesus compared his people to the salt of the earth. We, like salt, should be spread out to "season" a very unsavory world. Our job is to bring hope to the hopeless, careworn, and oppressed. "*Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.*" **Col 4:6**

Not surprisingly, helping others has been shown to help us live longer too. "*Researchers at the University of Michigan discovered a remarkable link between volunteer work and longevity by surveying 1,211 adults over 65 (mostly retirees) and checking up on them eight years later. Those who volunteered at least 40 hours each year to a single cause were 40 percent more likely than non-volunteers to be alive at the end of study."
